We are pleased to place a work order with you as per your Quotation dated 08.04.2024 upon M/s Chhabra Marketing for the work under subject (Hereinafter referred to as the "Work order") in accordance with the terms & conditions mentioned hereunder:

1. Scope of Work:
  - a) The detailed Scope of work is mentioned in enclosed **Schedule-A**.
  - b) Accommodation for Labour & Staff to be arranged by the Subcontractor.
2. This being a contract on unit rate basis, payment will be made 25% after Signing the work order as advance for material procurement, another 25% of payment made after material reached at site and rest of 50% payment made after satisfactory completion of work. the measurement as recorded by the representative of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. shall be final & binding upon you and no further discussions / disputes, of any nature will be entertained at any time thereafter.
3. It should be clearly understood that no escalation of price increase of any nature is admissible during the entire period of this contract till completion of the same. The rates agreed upon under this contract for said works are firm, final & binding and shall not be revised upwards under any circumstances. All machinery/equipment required would be arranged by yourself.
4. The rates have already been agreed upon considering idle times resulting due to delay in obtaining statutory permissions, sanctions, drawings etc. or any unforeseen circumstances whatsoever. Therefore, raising any claims for the idle labour charges, plants, machineries & equipment's or any other reason will not be entertained.
5. Work shall commence immediate on receipt of this order in consultation with the Site In-charge. We reserve the right to increase or decrease the quantum of work without any change whatsoever in the rates. We reserve the right to terminate the work in case of inferior/irregular workmanship, as may be determined solely & at the discretion of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd.
6. **IT IS EXPRESSLY STIPULATED THAT TIME IS THE MAIN ESSENCE OF THIS CONTRACT.** This contract work has to be satisfactorily completed within the specified time from the date of issue of this work order as agreed with our Projects in Charge and as per the attached 'Schedule-B', which is being accepted & acknowledged by you. Penalties of 0.5% of agreement amount per week delay



subject to a maximum 5% will be imposed and immediately recovered. We reserve the rights to review penalty rates if situation so demands according to us.

7. It will be your duty and responsibility for sorting out problems, difficulties, troubles and bottlenecks on & around the work sites and to take appropriate remedial steps immediately so as to completely ensure that all works are carried out properly, smoothly and within the stipulated time limit. M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd shall not be liable or responsible to sort out any such problems.
8. It shall be your liability & responsibility to provide adequate qualified, skilled & experienced personal to ensure acceptable quality of works and the completion of the works in the specified time period only. In case of any defective, substandard or below specification work is found, it will be your responsibility to make good the defect.
9. You will carry out the work as per the directions and instructions of the Engineer In-charge of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. time to time. You shall maintain instruction book at site. The instructions / comments received from the Engineer In-charge of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. should be complied forthwith and immediate remedial action taken by you should also be noted therein & shown to Engineer In-charge of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. You shall augment your above resources depending upon the exigencies of work and as decided or instructed from time to time by the Engineer In-charge of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd.
10. You shall be totally responsible for entire safety of your labours, supervisors and surrounding areas of the work sites where you work, and you will use PPEs (will be issued one time by M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. on returnable basis) such as Safety Shoes, Safety Belts, Safety Gloves, Helmets, Masks, Goggles etc. and various other protective equipment's to ensure that the workers are working under utmost safety conditions.
11. In every case in which by virtue of any section of Workmen's Compensation Act, you will pay compensation to any workmen / person(s) employed by you over the entire work site, in execution of the Work order / Agreement. In case of any such default, M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd., without prejudice have the right to recover such amounts or any part thereof by deducting it from security deposited or any other deposits, retention money or from any sums due by M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. to You. M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. will never be liable for any claims made against it, under the said Act.
12. It will be your sole responsibility to comply with all concerned Statutory Acts and Laws and various liabilities during the entire period of this contract till its satisfactory completion i.e. you will ensure that all type of Labour Laws, necessary Insurance Policies are taken out for men, material, equipment, vehicles, Minimum Wages Act, Provident Fund Act, Employees State Insurance Act, and also pay to the Government all Taxes, cess, duties and any other dues which arises out of this contract being given to you. If any kind of License is to be obtained in the name of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. relating to your scope of work, then you will have to submit and follow up for the same at your cost.
13. Statutory Standard Deduction to be made from each RA Bill submitted by you will mainly be as under:
  - a. Income Tax Deduction at source and also any other statutory deductions under the various Laws, Act, as per prevailing rates and rules from time to time. The given price in the schedule "A". are excluding of GST and inclusive of material cost.
  - b. Any other deductions / adjustments that may be arise as per M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. decision in the course of this contract being awarded.
14. No material / equipment / machineries brought in by yourself can be taken away from site by you or any of your agents or creditors etc. without the written consent of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. Only the Engineer In-charge is authorized to sign such authority letters. All stores and materials



delivered and kept on the premises to form the part of the work shall be considered the property of M/s CSR Infratech India Pvt Ltd. and shall not be removed without its written consent.

15. The Company can terminate this Agreement at any time without assigning any reasons, without entertaining any claims for labour or material or any other expenses or damages, in case of non-performance of contracting conditions.
16. **DAMAGE TO PROPERTY:** During your execution of work, if any property (whether it would be owned by Government or Private individuals or anybody whatsoever) is damaged to any extent, then the responsibility and liability arises on yourselves and you will be solely responsible for immediate payment of such damages, compensations, expenses etc.
17. **Arbitration:** All disputes, differences, claims and questions, whatsoever, which shall arise either during the subsistence of this Agreement or afterwards between the parties and/or their respective representatives touching these presents or any clause or thing herein, contained or otherwise in any way relating to or arising from these presents shall be referred to the arbitrations of two arbitrators, one to be appointed by each party to the dispute and such arbitration shall be in accordance with and subject to the previous of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or reenactment thereof for the time being in force.
18. In the event of a dispute between the parties settled in a Commercial Court in Hyderabad, the resolution would typically be in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations governing commercial disputes in that jurisdiction.

All other terms & conditions vide your quotation under reference submitted earlier, if any stands cancelled.

This work has to be carried out at our above-mentioned site considering following terms & Conditions:

### **I. Scope of Work**

- 1. Supply and Installation of 3M Road Sign Boards and other allied works back to back as per contract No. NHIDCL/JICA/NH-54-Miz-2017-18-158/Package-4/2018-19 dated 13.02.2019 for Construction of widening and upgradation to 2 lane with paved shoulder configuration and geometric improvements from km 166.000 to km 208.000 on Aizawl-Tuipang section of NH-54 in the state of Mizoram on EPC mode. All terms and conditions of the contract will be liable to the sub-contractor.**
- 2. All consumables & tools for its application will be arranged by vendor on its own cost.**
- 3. The contractor shall be solely responsible for above mentioned work and shall take care of all quality, safety, and other statutory requirements as per this work order/agreement and governing laws. The contractor shall also be responsible for any delay in execution of work or dissatisfactory work, if the above said work not executed on time and as per the specification.**
- 4. The obligations under the technical specifications as applicable to the main contract between NHIDCL and GP Projects Ltd. shall be applicable to this contract also.**
- 5. GP Projects Ltd. will not have any financial implications in any form regarding your scope of work and reserves the right to withdraw the entire/balance scope of work from you and complete the works at your risk and cost in case of your failure to deliver and perform as per the agreed terms and time frame. In case of abandonment of work from your end on any ground or pretext. a penalty for an amount equal to ten percent of the work done value shall be deducted/ forfeited from your final bill.**

**IV. Defect Liability Period / Warranty**

Defect liability period shall be of 02 years from the date of completion of all works and successfully handed over to / accepted by the engineer-In-charge. You shall provide warranty on HIP sheet (Retro Reflective sheet) for 7 years.

**V. Price and Payments**

1. Price: The total price for the items of work with the tentative quantities given in the priced bill of quantities enclosed as (Annexure-1) at accepted rates indicated therein for the subject scope of work defined in this work order. The rates shall remain firm & fixed for any variation in quantities.
2. The Payment will be made as per this work order rates for quantities Certified by the principal employer /client i.e. NHIDCL.
3. All payments shall be made subject to deductions as per this work order/agreement, government law and good industry practice. The deductions include: -
  - a. All applicable statutory deductions, taxes including tax TDS, GST, Labour Cess as per relevant laws, rules and regulations as applicable time to time.

1. 3. **The contractors Indemnity for Accidents or Injury to Workmen**  
The contractor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties from and against any and all loss, damage and expenses of whatsoever kind and nature (including all related costs





and expenses) in respect of the death of or injury to any person employed by contractor in connection with the performance of the works.

**XIII. Statutory Deductions**

All statutory deductions shall be made at source as applicable time to time.

**XIV. Escalation**

No escalation would be allowed and payable in any circumstances to the contractor even though the quantity of the work may increase substantially. The rates agreed shall remain firm and fixed during the contract period and shall not be subject to any increase/escalation due to any reason.

**XV. General**

1. The contractor will observe all provisions of labour Laws/Acts and rules as applicable to this scope of supply and safety rules and regulation and enforce the same on all Workmen/Staff. You will also be responsible for the good conduct of the staff.
2. The contractor is liable and responsible for complying with the provisions of the Employees Provident Fund, ESI Act 1948 and Miscellaneous provision Act 1952 (Latest revision) and schemes flawed there under, in so far they are applicable to this work order's scope.
3. All tools and tackles needed for the scope of order shall be provided by you unless otherwise specified. If any machinery, tools and plants are provided by the buyer, same shall be properly utilized /maintained by you.
4. The contractor will not appoint any child labour (labour less than 18 years old) for this scope of supply.
5. The contractor's Engineer/Staff are not permitted to stay and work at site in alcoholic impression in site/office premises, if any engineer /staff observed such condition the project in -charge's decision will be final and binding.
6. The contractor's Engineer/staff will not be permitted to store /use any hazardous material in hutment at project.
7. It is explicitly understood that you have acquainted yourself with site conditions, surrounding and no extra will be paid for any incorrect assumption of site conditions.
8. The contractor shall provide insurance cover for its staff/engineers.
9. Accommodation of manpower will be provided by GP Projects Ltd. at site
10. Raw Materials for RMC will be provided by GP Projects Ltd. at site.
11. Fooding for staff and workers to be arrange by subcontractor (M/s Chhabra marketing)
12. Provision of required welding machine, tools, & tackles, security for its belonging shall be in subcontractor's scope.
13. Subcontractor shall be responsible for unloading, loading & shifting of its equipments & supplied materials within site.
14. Electricity, Water, Store, Crane, Scaffolding working platform or Jambo & access of site for materials and manpower to be provided by the GP Projects Ltd.

**XVI. Occupational Health & Safety Requirements**

The sub-contractor shall take full responsibility for adequate stability and safety of all site operations and methods of construction, subject to provisions of expected risks and special risks. The sub-contractor shall arrange and implement the same for safety in his operations.

In accordance with GP Projects Ltd. Occupational Health & Safety policy, it is the responsibility of GP Projects Ltd. and its Subcontractor to provide both safe working conditions and protection against health risks to all employees and other involved. **under this contract, the sub-contractor shall ensure the following measures:**

1. Comply with all applicable laws, regulations, ordinances, statutes, rules, IS codes governing Occupational Health & Safety requirements and ALSO perform the work as per contractual requirements.
2. Ensure availability and use of proper personal protective equipment during execution of work.
3. Ensure safety induction by HSE Department to all sub-contractor workers prior to deployment at site.
4. Ensure safety clearance from HSE Department for the vehicles/equipment /machineries to be





deployed during execution.

5. Ensure awareness to all concerned regarding Safety and Health Hazard involved in the activity being undertaken.
6. All accidents /incidents should be reported immediately to HSE Department.
7. Ensure hygienic condition and proper housekeeping at work place as well as at the accommodation provided in line with regulatory requirements.
8. The sub-contractor shall be solely responsible for any claim and/or liability arising due to non-compliance of above measures and shall indemnify GP Projects Ltd. for the same.

**XVII. Environmental requirements**

Throughout performance of the work, the Subcontractor shall carry out all operations in such a way as to minimize / control / restrict ADVERSE impact upon the natural environment and prevent any spread AND / OR release of contaminated AND / OR hazardous substances in or around surroundings. It is the responsibility of GP PROJETS and its Subcontractor to manage the Project activities in such a manner to reduce ADVERSE environmental impacts OF ANY KIND to a practicable minimum. Under this contract, the sub-contractor shall ensure the following measures:

1. Comply with all applicable laws, regulations, ordinances, statutes, and rules, codes governing environmental requirements and also perform the work as per contractual requirements.
2. Create awareness amongst your staff to ensure compliance with the same.
3. Prevent and control any air, water, noise and soil pollution arising from your various activities.
4. Optimize utilization of water and non-renewable sources like materials, fuel and energy.
5. Control spillage including management of spilled materials from all pertinent operations.
6. Provide all documentation required by GP Projects Ltd./Client/ Governing authority on environmental requirements including Environmental Compliance Plan for review and approval.
7. Immediately notify GP Projects Ltd., in case it discovers any toxic or hazardous material.
8. Manage, store, and dispose of all hazardous waste generated by your OPERATIONS in compliance with regulatory.
9. The sub-contractor shall be solely responsible for any claim and/or liability arising due to non-compliance of above measures and shall indemnify GP Projects Ltd. for the same.

**XVIII. Site Information**

You shall make your own independent inquiries regarding the tender information related to the site conditions and verify the same, any claims on account of any deviations or incorrectness of above referred information shall be considered as inadmissible. You shall obtain all information relating to local regulations, bye-laws and all regulations applicable to your work. Any claims in this regard shall be inadmissible.

**XIX. Termination of Contract on Breach of Condition**

1. In case the contractor fails, neglects, or refuses to observe, perform, fulfill and keep, all or any one or more or any part of any one of the covenants, stipulations and provisions herein contained, it shall be lawful for the client on any such failure, neglect or refusal, to put an end to this work order/agreement and thereupon every article, cause and thing herein contained on the part of the client shall cease and be void, and in case of any damage, loss, expense, differences in cost or other expenditures then or at any time during the continuance of this work order/agreement becoming due or owing by the contractor to the client, it will be open for the client to recover the same from the contractor, all such damages, losses, expenses, differences in cost or other expenditures from out of any amount for the time being payable to the contractor under this and / or any other work order/agreement and in case such last mentioned amounts are insufficient to cover all such damages, losses, expenses, differences in cost and other amounts as aforesaid, it shall be recovered from the contractor.





2. The client reserves the right to terminate the contract / agreement either wholly or in part with proper notice to the contractor. The contractor will not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever in respect of such termination of the contract / agreement by the client.


**XX. Dispute Mechanism:**
